



EGG CARTON FEEDER

You can build a simple birdfeeder by recycling items like a two-liter soda bottle, egg carton or a paper towel cardboard tube. This is a great afternoon project and an opportunity for you to give your community bird a tasty snack!



WHAT YOU'LL NEED FIG.1

1. A cardboard egg carton
2. Yarn, string, wire or colored ribbon
3. Birdseed
4. Scissors
5. Marker

Instructions:

- Cut off the lid of an egg carton and discard the top portion
- Make small holes in all four corners of the egg carton
- Thread and tie a piece of string, wire or ribbon through each hole
- Fill each individual egg holder with birdseed or cereal

Hang the feeder in your backyard or outside of your classroom and watch for birds! (fig.2)
